Internal IDP: According to the latest reports of the United Nations Development Program, Afghanistan has 6.55 million internally displaced people. This number ranks second in the world after Syria. Of this population, more than 4.39 million people have been displaced as a result of ongoing conflicts and violence until December 2022, while another 2.16 million people have been displaced due to environmental events in this country.
